EXCLUSIVE Becks' £25k on kids' Santa Reindeer pull sleigh full of gifts Home turned into wonderland

David Beckham is paying £25,000 to have Santa deliver his children's Christmas presents.

The lookalike will arrive at David and Victoria's £7million Hertfordshire mansion on a sleigh pulled by real reindeer and weighed down with lavish gifts for Brooklyn, 8, Romeo, 5, and Cruz, 2. Father Christmas will be played by Britain's top Santa impersonator - an actor called Rex who runs a school for would-be Santas in Weston-super-Mare, Somerset. He already has a string of wealthy clients, including David's best pal, Phil Neville, who is said to have given him the idea.

Becks - nicknamed "Goldenballs" - and Posh, who have been living in Los Angeles since July, have also hired a leading interior design firm called The Christmas Decorators to transform Beckingham Palace into a winter wonderland complete with thousands of sparkling lights, human-size toy soldiers, giant lollipops and "Lapland" in the garden. A source said: "It may seem extravagant, but they want to let their kids know they've been really good this year, especially with the move to the States."
